Description Tthe service API is currently broken for me. POSTing to a tracker item like http://tiki.local/api/trackers/1/items/2 succeeds, but redirects me to "Location: item2" which is http://tiki.local/api/trackers/1/items/item2 and doesn't exist.

This partially breaks the kanban board, but probably other things using the api.

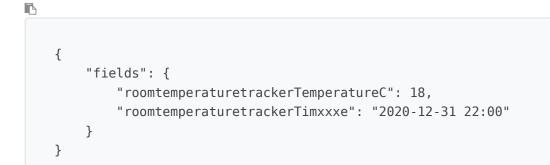

I was sending the request in a wrong way, by sending request as formData with field name in brackets eg. fields [roomtemperaturetrackerTemperatureC] i was able to POST on https://tikicms.test/api/trackers/{trackerID}/items/{itemID} using postman and the item was edited, i did not see any redirection in the response header and the api just returned the expected json response.

So @benoit.gregoire how to reproduce this bug?
