I've looked into a number of threads/trackers on this topic, and while I'm not 100% sure, I would expect this to be solved (at least in recent tikis / tiki manager / wikisuite).

I've done also some tests (screen shoot attached) and seems to work.

I created a `tmpsource` instance and then clone it to a `tmpdest` instance, the `tmpDir` pref gets reset as part of the clone.

There is some thing on the report above that are troubling, namely the fact that the `tmpDir` of the tiki was pointing to the `tmp` folder to be used by tiki manager - that should never have happen.

Instead of spending more time on this one, I'll sync with @Marc on one of the upcoming calls and/or offline.
