Description

If you take a look at the files attached to the description of <https://avan.tech/item42073> for example, you will see that some of them have a "cogwheel in a file" icon instead of a thumbnail.

Also, in my case, clicking their filenames to download them did not directly download them (in Firefox) like the other images (that are regular JPEGs), the browser prompted me about what I wanted to do with them... but I'm not sure if it was Tiki doing something weird, or if it was just a wrong mimetype setting in my browser (setting it to default to "Save file" instead of "Show in Firefox" made it work)

Uploading a webp image file through the image upload button in the wiki page editor's toolbar (even it non-WYSIWYG, markdown-only mode) correctly uploads and inserts the file, but is unable to display it directly on the page on Tiki 25. Clicking the "cogwheel" thumbnail icon for it... shows it in lightbox, without problems. So the server/browser is perfectly capable of displaying those files, but for some reason Tiki itself isn't doing that.
