But it was related to some files manually edited on the [dogfood5 server](#) on the Virtualmin server copydoc.tiki.org probably for debugging purposes, as shown below



I restored some of them (index.php, tiki-index.php, tiki-index\_p.php, templates/header.tpl, etc) to keep the copydoc.tiki.org website cleaner, and the issue could be fixed.
